VIII. Business

Deputy Superintendent Laurie King

- a. Approval of Policy Services Advisories 602-615 (Action Item)- It is recommended the Governing Board approve the Policy Services Advisories 602-615 provided by Arizona School Boards Association in February of 2018. The first two reads were conducted and approved in 2018. The final approval was not documented.
- b. Time and Effort Reporting (Action Item)- It is recommended the Governing Board adopt the time and effort reporting requirements set forth under Federal Uniform Grant Guidance 2 CFR 200.430 Compensation for all employees whose positions are funded by a state or federal grant.
- c. Gifts and Donations (Action Item)- It is recommended that the Governing Board approve the donation of \$1,200 from Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. to Hope Academy for Thanksgiving meals.
